## Explore Your Housing Options

  - Estimated Cost: \$1,000–\$1,500 CAD per month.

- **Shared Housing or Rentals:**  
Share an apartment or house with other students to save on costs.
  - Estimated Cost: \$800–\$1,500 CAD per month (per room).
- **Private Apartments:**  
Rent a private studio or one-bedroom apartment for more independence.
  - Estimated Cost: \$1,800–\$2,500 CAD per month.
- **Short-Term Rentals:**  
If you need temporary accommodations while searching for long-term housing, consider hostels or short-term rental services.

## Understand Your Tenancy Rights

As a tenant in British Columbia, you are protected under the Residential Tenancy Act, which ensures your rights and responsibilities as a renter. Key points include:

- You have the right to live in a safe and well-maintained property.
- Landlords must provide proper notice for rent increases or entering the property.
- Tenants are responsible for paying rent on time and maintaining the property in good condition.

- Be cautious of deals that seem too good to be true—they often are.
- Verify rental listings by cross-checking details on multiple platforms or contacting landlords directly.
